Impacts Overview

- Persistent moderate to strong onshore winds over the Gulf of Mexico keeping tides about a foot above normal
- Surface low forecast to develop over western Gulf late in the weekend and will bring rain chances back to the area
 - 2 to 3 inches of rain possible Sunday through Wednesday

Chance of Cyclone Formation in 5 Days: Cover and Section 2000 pm ED1 1 the Oct 27 2016 X indicates current disturbance location; shading indicates potential formation area.



This Afternoon Through Saturday




 Continued dry conditions
Afternoon relative humidity starting to increase as moisture returns to area

Wind speeds away from LA coast should generally stay below 10 mph except in gusts




Sunday Through Wednesday

- Surface low forecast to develop over western Gulf late in the weekend and will bring rain chances back to the area
- Below average confidence in exact track and timing of the low
- High confidence that we will see at least some rain



Daily Rainfall Forecast



Exact Totals will depend on track of low



Summary of Impacts

- Continued dry conditions through Saturday
- Showers and thunderstorms expected to return to the area Sunday through Wednesday
 - Below average confidence in exact timing
- Storm total rainfall 2 to 3 inches. Local amounts could be higher.
 - High confidence that we will see at least some rain
 - Near average confidence in amounts.
