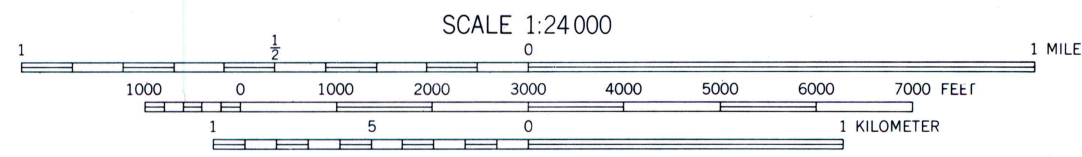
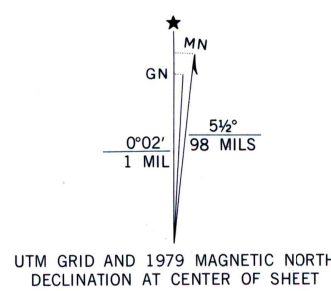

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Louisiana coordinate system, south zone (Lambert conformal conic). 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 15 1927 North American datum.

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 20 meters south and 16 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
