

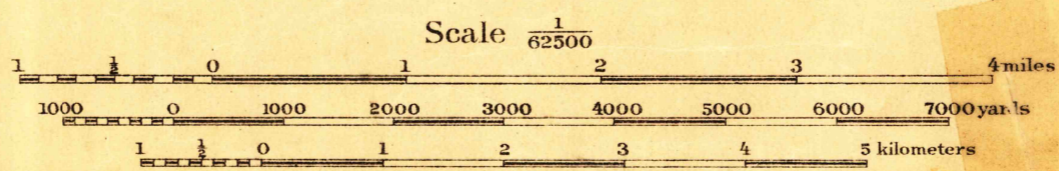

GRID ZONE "C"



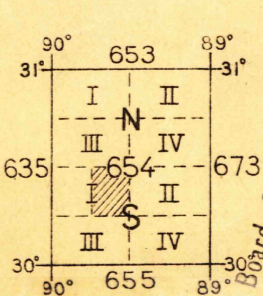
