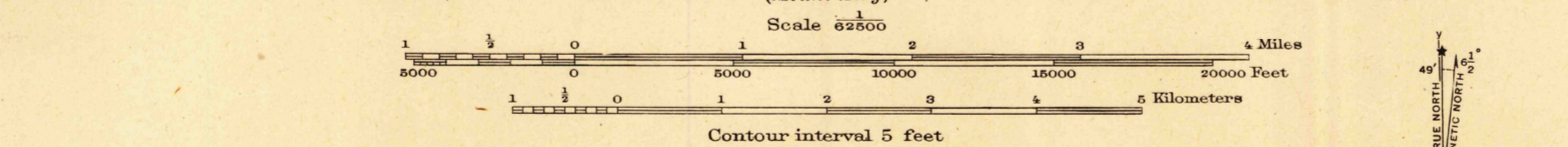




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Descriptions, elevations and geodetic positions of bench marks may

Distances above mouth of Tickfaw River are shown at 5 mile intervals.
Distances above mouth of Natalbany River are shown at 5 mile intervals.

Datum is mean sea level. Elevations differ from mean gulf level elevations at Biloxi, Mississippi by small fractions of a foot. Persons interested may secure elevations of bench marks as determined by the latest U. S. C. & G. S. adjustment, by applying to the U. S. Coast and Geodetic Survey.
