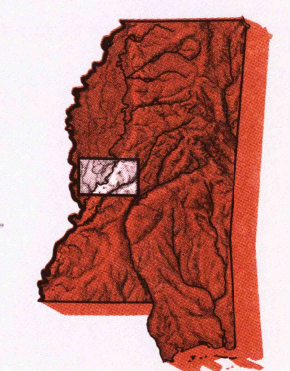


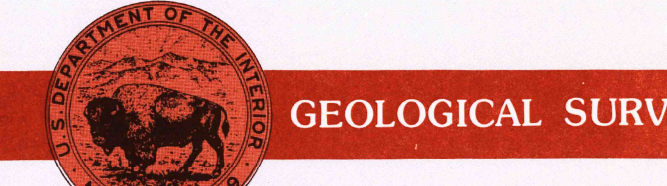
# Yazoo City MISSISSIPPI-LOUISIANA
