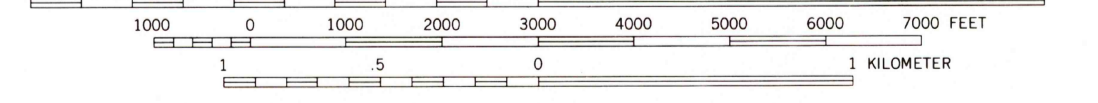


FORT POLK MILITARY RESERVATION

PEASON RIDGE ARTILLERY RANGE

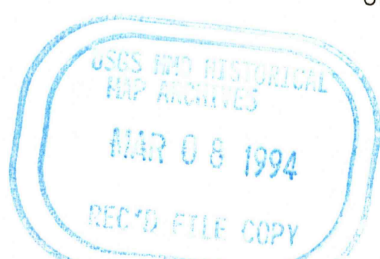
