

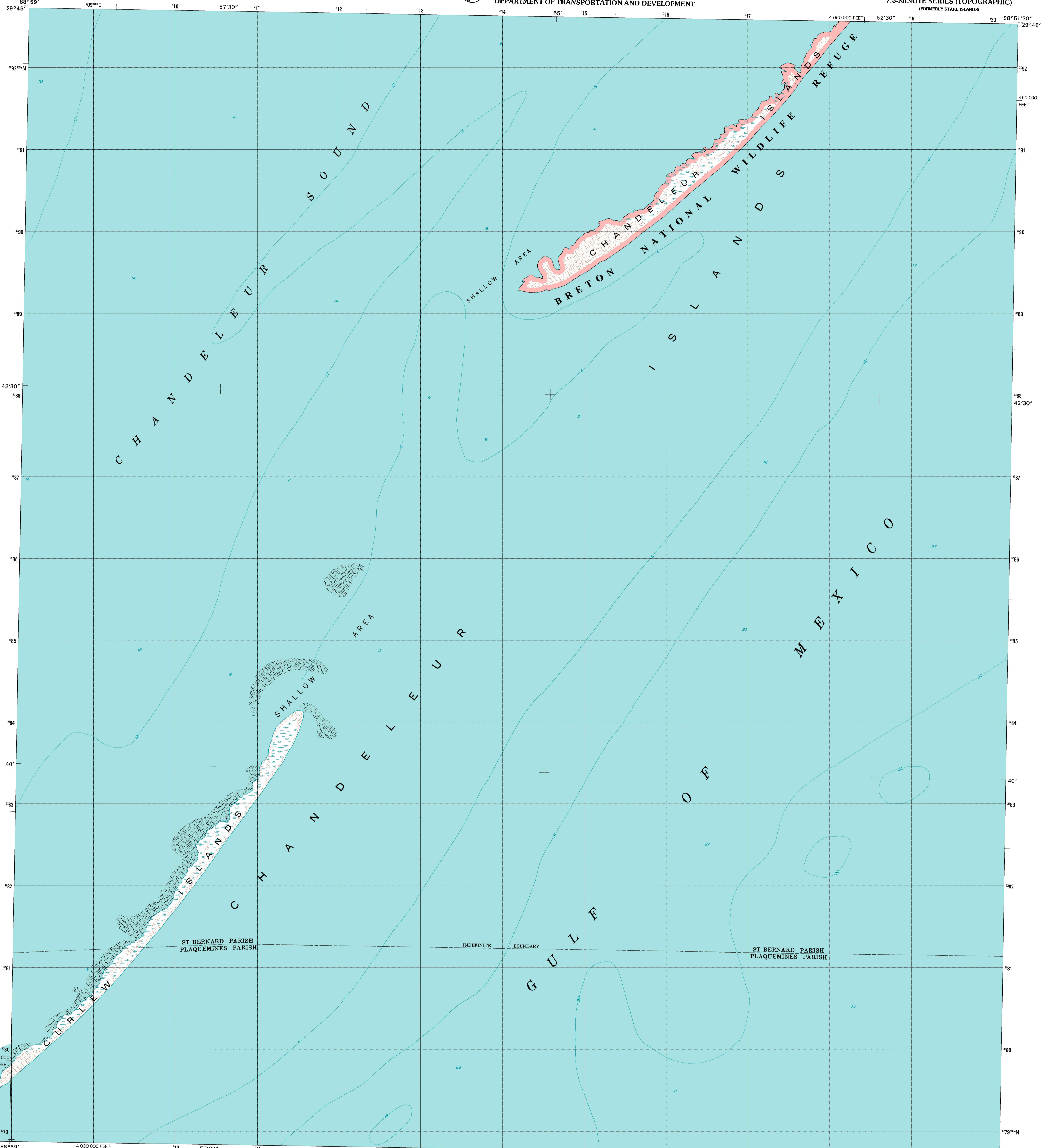

National Geodetic Survey NADCON software

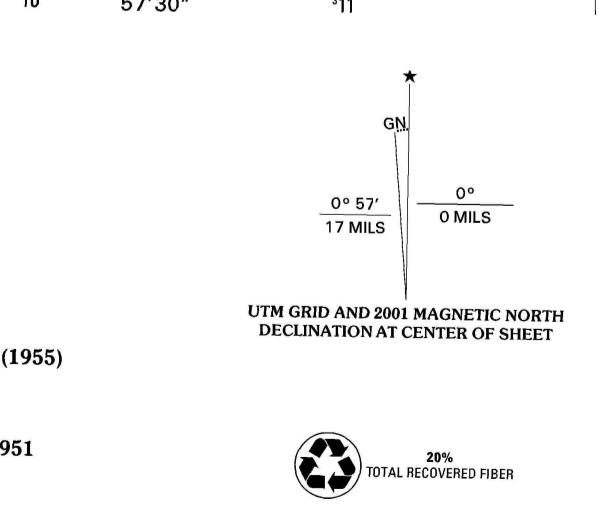
