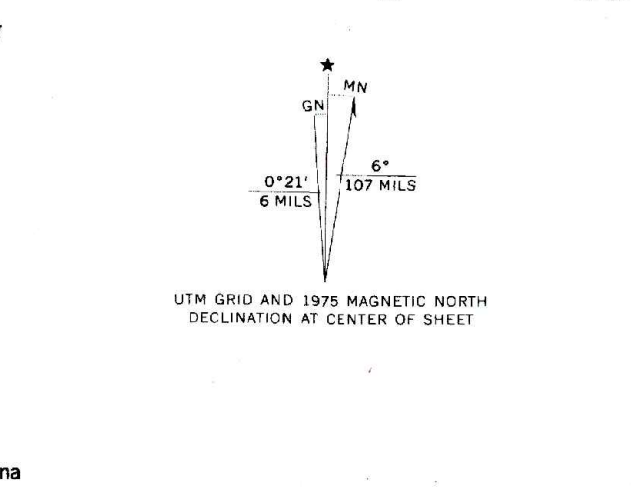

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grids based on Louisiana coordinate system, south zone and Texas coordinate system, central zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 19 meters south and 17 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations
Dotted land lines established by private survey for the State of Louisiana
